Oral Presentation

For each oral presentation 15 min are allocated including the discussion time. Speakers are requested to prepare their presentations brief. On-line presentations (via Skype) can be arranged for registered foreign participants on request; certificate of participation will be sent to them by post. A Gold Medal will be awarded to the best oral presenter.

Poster Presentation
