Terms of Participation

Please read the following policy regarding conference.

- 1. As we are receiving a large number of abstracts the Organizing Committee has decided that **an author will present only one paper as oral presentation**. However, there is **no limitation for Poster Presentations.** The authors of the Abstracts that have been accepted for Oral Presentations are requested to **communicate the Abstract No. and the name(s) of the Presenting Author(s)** for their respective papers as soon as possible.
- 2. Some authors have submitted more than one Abstracts. We have accepted one of their abstracts for Oral Presentation and the rest have been considered as Poster presentation. However, they may **have a chance to change their preference**. Please communicate your preference as soon as possible by mentioning Abstract No of the papers to be presented.
- 3. All Abstracts presented in the conference (Oral or Poster) will get equal opportunity for publication in conference proceedings. However, their final acceptance for publication solely will depend on the evaluation and subsequent recommendation by the two potential reviewers.
- 4. The conference proceedings will consists an special issues of PJB and a Book
- 5. An abstract published in the Conference "Abstract Book" and not presented orally or as poster will **NOT** be published in the Conference Proceedings.
- 6. Only registered participants will get Accommodation, Bags, Writing Pads, Badges and Certificates *etc*.
- 7. All authors willing to present their research work (as oral or poster presentation) will **register at least 15 days before the start of the conference**. Failing this, the organizing committee cannot guarantee the presentation of their research work.
- 8. It is necessary to **get registered once** for any participant who whishes to present oral or poster presentation
- 9. Although registration will continue till the start of the conference, however, participants registered before 10 April, 2008 will get preference regarding accommodation, bags, Abstract Book, Certificate etc. Please get registered at the earliest.
- 10. We will try our best to provide accommodation to all participants (International and from cities other than Faisalabad), however, **no travel support will be provided** to any participant.

11. At this time, participants are required to submit **abstracts** of the paper only and **not the full papers**. We will request for the full paper after the completion of the conference and when the conference proceedings will be published.

Guide Line for Oral Preparation

12. Participants interested for **Oral Presentation** will prepare their presentations in **Microsoft Office PowerPoint** (preferably 2003 Edition) compatible format. Please do not bring transparencies *etc*.

Guide Line for Poster Preparation

13. Participants interested for **Poster Presentation** will prepare their presentation with following specifications. Failing this they may not get a chance to present their research work in the conference.

- a. **Poster Size** = Width 32 and height 42 inches or 80 x 105 cm
- b. **Columns** = 3 starting from left side to downwards
- c. **Font:** Times New Roman throughout the text
- d. Minimum Font Size: 16 Point
- e. Maximum Font size: To fit the available space
- f. Line Spacing: Single throughout the text.
- g. Page Margin: 1 inch on all sides
- h. **Sections:** must include Title, Author(s), Affiliation, Abstract, Introduction, Materials and Methods, Results and Discussion (under a single heading), Conclusions and References. Acknowledgement is optional a section.

i. Sections Specifications:

- i. Title [no section heading. bold, centered, ALL CAPITALS]
- ii. Authors [no section heading, bold, centered, Title Case, do not abbreviate]
- iii. Affiliation [no section heading, given for all authors, left aligned]
- iv. ABSTRACT [section heading, maximum 10-15 line, justified]
- v. Key words: [no keywords]
- vi. INTRODUCTION [section heading, one paragraph of 10-15 lines, justified]
- vii. MATERIALS AND METHODS [section heading, give brief description of methodology adapted, justified]
- viii. **RESULTS AND DISCUSSION** [section heading, in a single section, key results, must include tables, figures or illustrations, justified]
- ix. CONCLUSIONS [section heading, maximum 4, justified]
- x. **REFERENCES** [section heading, maximum 3, justified]
- xi. **ACKNOWLEDGEMENT** [section heading, only if required, maximum 2 lines, justified]
